- What historic issues does the audio/video address?
- What is the audio/video's thesis or point of view?
- What evident is used to support the thesis? How accurate is the evidence? Has relevant or conflicting evidence been omitted?
- How valid is the audio/video's argument?
- What has the audio/video accomplished?
- Your online audio/video review should be 2 or more pages (read the instructions in the collection), double-spaced, 1 inch margins, in 12-point font.
